

SPRING CONCERT LETTER #1

Dear Dancers and Parents,

As you all know we are beginning preparations for our Spring Dance Concert. PLEASE READ THIS LETTER CAREFULLY AS IT CONTAINS A LOT OF IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION! In order to keep costs down, we are very excited to present this year's show at the new state of the art Westbrook Performing Arts Center located at 471 Stroudwater Street Westbrook, ME. There will be two evening performances, Friday and Saturday June 18th & 19th at 7:30 pm and a matinee Saturday June 19th at 12:30. Advanced teen and adult repertory classes will be performing in both evening shows. All other classes will dance in only one show. We do our very best to keep families with more than one dance class in one show, but it is impossible to accommodate everyone. Students in more than one class or siblings dancing in different classes may be scheduled in each performance.

Each class has been assigned to either the Friday or Saturday show. Dance Imagination (4yrs & up), Dance Basics and the Combo classes will perform in the Saturday Matinee. We are in the process of sending home detailed costume slips describing costumes and related costs. You will find which night your child dances on the back of this page. A detailed rehearsal schedule for each performance will follow this letter shortly.

We will need volunteers to help out backstage and sit in the auditorium during the performances. Volunteers will be able to see some of the show. If you are interested in volunteering please sign up at the front desk.

We will be raffling a fall 14 class dance card a \$196 value for \$2 per ticket or 3 for \$5, available at the dance studio and at the show. In addition look for the beautiful flowers you can buy for your dancer in the lobby at all the performances. All the proceeds will benefit The Portland Youth Dance scholarship program.

EVENING PERFORMANCES:

Seating for the shows is general admission. Tickets will be available starting Monday May 24th. Advanced ticket prices for the evening shows are \$16 (\$14 for senior citizens, ages 65+ and children 10 and under). You may purchase tickets at Casco Bay Movers Dance Studio until Wednesday June 16th. Starting Thursday June 17th tickets are \$19 (\$17 for senior citizens, ages 65+ and children 10 and under) and will only be available at the Westbrook Performing Arts Center Box Office during rehearsal times only, and one hour prior to the shows. There will be no exchanges or refunds for tickets.

MATINEE PERFORMANCE:

Seating for the shows is general admission. Tickets will be available starting Monday May 24th. Advanced ticket prices for the evening shows are \$13 (\$11 for senior citizens, ages 65+ and children 10 and under). You may purchase tickets at Casco Bay Movers Dance Studio until Wednesday June 16th. Starting Thursday June 17th tickets are \$16 (\$14 for senior citizens, ages 65+ and children 10 and under) and will only be available at the Westbrook Performing Arts Center Box Office during rehearsal times only, and one hour prior to the shows. There will be no exchanges or refunds for tickets.
